Arriving at the 8th floor of the Ringstraße hotel is a journey to the Riviera, where an exuberant evening awaits. Florian Weitzer has crafted Limón as a sensory haven, a place where zest for life and enjoyment can be fully embraced: in the Mediterranean ambiance of the restaurant, on the terrace with a panoramic view, and, of course, on the menu. The infusion of Southern culinary delights at the rooftop of the otherwise Austrian-influenced Grand Ferdinand is attributed to the owner's travels: "I've explored the menus of Italy, France, and Spain for many vacations, and I'm proud to offer the best from these three culinary worlds in one place, "expresses Florian Weitzer. He jovially faces the "Battle of the Giants," referring to the choice between the famous Wiener Schnitzel at Meissl & Schadn on the ground floor and the Italian variant Cotoletta alla Milanese offered at Limón.

From Bouillabaisse Marseillaise to homemade Raviolo alla Carbonara to Pollo a la Mallorquina - at Limón, you embark on an evening journey from the Côte d'Azur to the Amalfi Coast, then on to Mallorca and back. The best

way to experience it is à la Family-Style, indulging in numerous taste explosions and notable names like Spaghetti all' Astice or Boeuf Bourguignon. Those who surrender to the seventh—or here, "eighth"—dessert heaven with a Limone di Amalfi filled with Panna Cotta or Crêpe Suzette can delight in the Limón bar cart directly at their table - all in the stylish Campari look. The bar offerings are specialized in the Italian cult drink and Aperitivo culture. Limón proudly collaborates with Campari, providing the perfect setting for a pure Mediterranean experience.

Since 2015, Grand Ferdinand on Schubertring has been a place that honors the finer things in life - a tradition continued with the new Limón. While the rooftop remains exclusively open to hotel guests during the day for breakfast, drinks, and poolside enjoyment, Limón opens its doors to everyone from Tuesday to Saturday night. It invites all who desire to celebrate the Mediterranean way of life high above the rooftops of Vienna. La vie est belle, n'est-ce pas?
